

Scrimmage Games Update (8/22/10)

The referees are told that:

“an unofficial game” or “scrimmage” may be played by the teams if they are missing a game card or player passes; all regular procedures are to be followed; the game may not be played if there are no coach passes, not enough team members and/or other rules of the game are not met.”

Questions from the Referee Meeting of 3/3/10 regarding scrimmages and Board responses:

1. Can players switch teams to make an even-sided scrimmage? **YES**
2. The coaches will have to give the referee a written ad hoc roster. Will the Board research the legitimacy of the players in the scrimmage? **YES**
3. Will fair play be maintained by application of all rules and disciplinary procedures? **YES**
4. Both coaches will be asked if they want to play a scrimmage; if one says no, they will not proceed with the scrimmage. **YES**
5. The time of the scrimmage halves will be determined by “doing the math” and making two equal halves in the remaining time slot allocated after setting up the scrimmage. **YES**
6. Teams may not recruit players that are not on the two teams scheduled to play. **YES**
