

Revised Referee Payment Schedule for the U13-19 Season

(effective for the U13-19 Season 2010)

Objectives:

1. to motivate referees to pursue upgrades by having game fees dependent on their referee grade.
2. to have referees receive more and advanced training.
3. to improve the quality of officiating for the Oahu League.

Notes:

- 1) the fee for grade 8 referees will decrease for each age group.
- 2) there are:
 - grade 5 = 2 referees
 - grade 6 = 4 referees
 - grade 7 = 10 referees
 - grade 15/16 = 4 referees
 - grade 8 = >4-500 referees
- 3) after selection, RIPS referees will be paid at the rate for their upgrade goal.
- 4) youth referees are encouraged to work with a mentor and enroll in RIPS.
- 5) if you are a grade 7 but not indicated so by the Registrar, you will receive the grade 8 rate; the same applies for grades 6 and 5.
- 6) payment is contingent on following all OL referee guidelines and procedues.
- 7) the OL Board may downgrade the pay to individual referees based upon their performance.
