

Referee Report for Send Offs

Procedures

Oahu League (OL) referees are to follow the procedures detailed below when filing a "Send Off" report (ejection or red card) for players or coaches.

1. First, at the field the **player pass** must be collected from the coach and included with the game card and "Sendoff Report" when it is mailed to the OL at Soccerama. The game card and pass must be mailed so that it reaches Soccerama within 48 hours (i.e., no later than Tuesday following a Sunday game); write "Red Card" on the envelope.

Send the following in to Soccerama by US mail:

for a player: 1) game card; 2) player pass, and; 3) sendoff report.

for a coach: 1) game card, and; 2) sendoff report.

Note: do not attempt to collect the Coach pass and lanyard which is around the coach's neck. When the Assignor is alerted by email or the 24 hr Notice Form that the the coach has received a sendoff, the referee for the next game will be notified that the coach is not eligible to participate as a coach for the duration of the sanction.

A separate report must be submitted for each player or coach sent off for misconduct.

2. Second, an alert of the sendoff must be sent to the Assignor by email notification (send to Assignor@oahuleague.com) or by using the 24 hr Notice Form on the webpage for each player and coach sendoff as soon as possible after the match.
3. Third, the written formal "Referee Report for Send Offs" must be completed and sent to the OL Assignor by email (Assignor@oahuleague.com) within 24 hours of the match. Each item in the report must be completed.

A separate report must be submitted for each player or coach sent-off for misconduct.

4. In describing the misconduct the referee must use only the seven offenses listed on the sendoff report. The referee must be precise, discriminating and selective in the wording and description of the misconduct as this information is used by the OL Disciplinary Committee to determine the sanctions the player or coach will receive.

The sanctions for misconduct which the OL uses in determining sanctions are described in "Rule 15 - Disciplinary Rulings and Punishments" of the Hawaii Youth Soccer Association Team Manual (starting on p. 21) or the text of Rule 15 may be reviewed on the webpage (go to the "Send Off Reports" link).
