

Please help the league by checking the standings and scores on a regular basis. It is not uncommon for scores to be misreported or for the standings to be miscalculated as the standings are manually entered into Excel Spreadsheets. With over 500 games scheduled per season, there are bound to be mistakes. The League Board Members who volunteer to post the standings appreciate your assistance in making sure that accurate standings and scores are posted.

Standing Abbreviations

PTS = points earned; cumulative (W = 3; L = 0; D = 1)

GP = games played

GD = goal Differential: cumulative; max/min of +3/-3 per game [-4 for losses designated by a forfeit].

GA = goals allowed: cumulative (unlimited)

GS = goals scored: cumulative (unlimited)

Tie-Breaker Situations

The standings are first determined by the total number of points accumulated by a team. In the event of a tie in the standings, a series of tie-breakers are employed to determine a winner. Overtime matches and penalty kicks are only utilized in certain play-off formats. Please confirm with your referee before the play-off match whether or not there may be overtime or penalty kicks after regulation is completed in a tie.

Tie-Breaker Sequence

- 1 Head-to-Head competition**
- 2 Goal Differential (see above for cap on GD)**
- 3 Goal Allowed**
- 4 Goals Scored**
- 5 Coin-Toss**

- " * " **designated tied teams ranked according to head-head results**
- " ° " **designated tied teams where other tie breaker used than head-head.**

these designations will only be used on final standings of a group or division

Reporting Corrections

If you encounter an incorrect score or standings calculation, please contact the **Age Group Coordinator** with all relevant information. Please include Game number, Date, Time, Field and all team numbers involved. In the case of a score change, the process involves contacting the opposing coach/team admin to confirm the different score as well as inspection of the game cards submitted by the referees. If 2 of the 3 sources confirm the different score (than posted online, the change will be made by the league.
